EUROPEAN RETURN CRITERIA

After you have made your pick-up notification, ensure that each returned FLUBOX® IBC meets the following criteria:

1. Each FLUBOX® IBC must report, in compliance with the current regulations, the label of the product last contained and, on demand, it must include all Hazardous Product Information.

2. Each FLUBOX® IBC must be delivered hermetically sealed; its washable* product residues must be less than 0,5% of the container volume (*with the exception of ink, colouring agents, adhesive, latex/resins).

3. FLUBOX® IBCs which contained toxic/hazardous products, according to ADR/RID art 2.2.61, can be accepted only after having been decontaminated, in compliance with the current regulations, and must be delivered to FUSTIPLAST as "no hazardous waste".

4. Decontaminated FLUBOX® IBCs must be marked as such (label, stamp, etc.); if highly irritant or bad smelling products have been contained, FUSTIPLAST can ask the sender to decontaminate the IBC.

5. Pallet and metal cage of FLUBOX® IBCs must be re-usable, they must neither be destroyed nor present deformations or substantial damages due to oxidation; the plastic bottle must be undamaged.

All the FLUBOX® IBCs that don't satisfy the above mentioned return regulations, will be refused and either returned to the sender or destroyed at the following conditions:

- transport costs, both for the withdrawal and the return, will be at the sender's charge;

- destruction costs, without exception, for the disposal of residual product more than 0,5% of the container volume, will be at the sender's charge;

- disposal costs for FLUBOX® IBCs with pallet/cage which are destroyed, deformed, or irreparably damaged from oxidation, or with a damaged bottle, will be at the sender's charge.

FILL OUT A PICK-UP NOTIFICATION

- A pick-up notification form can be obtained by visiting www.fustiplast.com or by calling +49(0) 6805-940057.
- Remember to fill out the form completely, to stamp it in the relevant space and to have it signed by the authorized person.
- Note the quantity of IBCs that are ready to be returned, the name of the product last contained and that of its producer.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

Once you have filled out and sent the pick-up notification form, here's what will happen:

- Within 30 business days after notification, you will be contacted by our driver in charge and you will be informed of the exact pick-up date.
- Just load the FLUBOX® IBCs stacking them 1+1.
- The FLUBOX® IBCs will be taken to an approved service facility where they will be recycled.

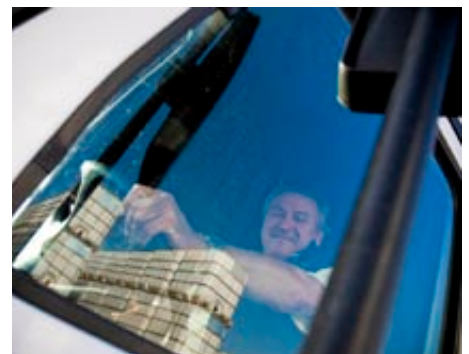

To benefit from the ReturnNet System for FLUBOX® IBCs, please fill-out this form and return it to the above fax number. This service will be carried out by FUSTIPLAST or one of its appointed companies within 30 days from receipt of the filled-out form for 6 FLUBOX® IBCs as minimum qty: the timeframe can be shortened in case of collections of 60 FLUBOX® IBCs at a time. Transportation charges will apply to pick-ups in remote locations or for smaller quantities and will be agreed with FUSTIPLAST case by case.

THE SENDER DECLARES THAT THE FLUBOX® IBCS HE WISHES TO BE COLLECTED

Can be classified as NON DANGEROUS waste since no dangerous substances are present inside the bottle in compliance with the regulations about classification, packaging and labelling of dangerous goods above the concentration limits established by 2001/118/CE, Art.2.

THIS FORM MUST ALWAYS BE ATTACHED TO THE TRANSPORTATION DOCUMENTS

The FLUBOX® IBCs must be marked with a sticker clearly indicating the product last contained in accordance with the current regulations and, upon request, the relevant safety data sheets must be provided.

The FLUBOX® IBCs will have to be presented for pick-up with all openings hermetically closed and they must be empty, i.e. drip dry and not trickling. Any excess products must be removed with usual competence.

The FLUBOX® IBCs that have contained toxic or noxious goods, in compliance with ADR/RID Art.2.2.61, can be accepted only after having been decontaminated according to the current regulations and must be given to FUSTIPLAST as “non dangerous waste”.

The decontaminated FLUBOX® IBCs must be marked as such (labels, stamps etc.). In case of substances last contained which are strongly irritating or exhale an intense smell, FUSTIPLAST may arrange for their decontamination at the Sender's charge.

The pallets and the cages of the FLUBOX® IBCs must be reusable and therefore free of cracks, deformations and substantial damages due to corrosion. The inner-bottle as well must show no damages.

All FLUBOX® IBCs not complying with the a.m. collection regulations, will be either sent back to the Sender or scrapped according to the following conditions:

- all transportation charges (both for the collection and the returning) will be at the Sender's charge;
- all costs, with no exception whatsoever, deriving from the disposal of residues above the 0,5% of the container volume, will be invoiced to the Sender (1,75 €/Kg).
- the costs for scrapping non-reusable FLUBOX® IBCs (pallets/cages which show cracks, deformations and/or substantial damages due to corrosion – damaged inner-bottle) will be invoiced to the Sender (41,00 €/cad).
